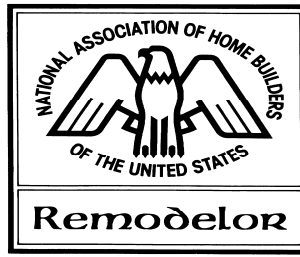

4. Start the construction process as soon as feasible upon award of a contract and proceed diligently to completion of the project without unnecessary delays.
5. Conduct their business operation in a manner that will reflect credit upon the remodeling industry in general and the Council in particular.
6. Issue a warranty covering materials and workmanship for a one (1) year period after completion of the work, with the exception of damage caused by normal shrinkage, wear and tear, abuse, or acts of God.
